

Statement on how the building product is expected to contribute to compliance:

- B2.3.1 (a), (b) and B2.3.2: COMPEGO tape meets these requirements. Provided it is not exposed to the weather or ultra-violet light for a total of more than 90 days, and provided the exterior cladding is maintained in accordance with the cladding manufacturer's instructions and the cladding remains weather resistant, COMPEGO tape is expected to have a serviceable life equal to that of the cladding. The maximum exposure period of the tape may however be limited by the requirements of the substrate manufacturer.
- E2.3.2: COMPEGO tape contributes to meeting this requirement.
- F2.3.1: COMPEGO tape meets this requirement and will not present a health hazard to people.
